In addition, we offer a free medical clinic for the underinsured or uninsured poor two days a week at the Saint Agnes Nurses Center. Outreach Services also provides Educational Support Programs for the young children of immigrant families to acculturate and prepare them for the American classroom and a lifelong love of learning. Our mission is "to do what we can to lessen the burdens of our neighbors in need".
